Please find below the email from Ady at Charge My Streets confirming the 5 year lease term for the charge point at the Nadder Close Car Park location. Please could you let me know who will liaise directly with Ady on the lease terms, so that I can make an introduction.

Ref the subscription charge - NCE will pay this entirely. Perhaps the parish might consider a % contribution for arranging for the provision of the additional public service charge point. Good news is that we've saved well over £5,000 in infrastructure installation costs for the parish.

The application to the DNO (district network operator) SSEN has already been submitted and we await their response on the exact location for the charge point. I'll keep you posted.

Hi Catherine

It was good to catch up with you again on Friday. As requested, here are Charge My Street's written answers to the points raised.

1. We can confirm that there will be no cost to the parish council for the installation of the two chargepoint sockets. The various costs will be borne by the SOSCI partners and will in turn be claimed back from Innovate UK. Ultimately the grant funding comes from OLEV (Office for Low Emission Vehicles).
2. Subscriptions rates are as outlined on our website. While the PAYG rate is 35p/kWh, we would expect the car club and other locals to take advantage of our subscription rates which equate to 22-23p/kWh.
3. We are happy to have a five year lease with the parish council, covering the remainder of their lease with the county council for the car park.

I hope this covers everything, any more questions just ask!
