18.03.37	<p><b>Catholic Church land</b> - Members of the Catholic Church will be attending to update the Parish council on the current plans.</p>	
<b>FINANCIAL MATTERS for RESOLUTION</b>		
18.03.38	<p><b>ACoRP (Association of Community Rail Partnerships)</b> - Parish Councils are able to contribute towards 'community transport schemes' under Section 144 of the LGA 1972 that permits contributions to organisations/initiatives encouraging tourism. P.Cnllrs are therefore requested to ratify the decision taken at the March full meeting to support the application of the local Community Rail Partnership and bank incoming grants as appropriate.</p>	
18.03.39	<p><b>Fingerpost letters</b> - P.Cnllrs will remember that the Area Board awarded a grant of 50% of the cost of 2 new fingerposts in the current financial year. The replacement finger post for the new bridge at the junction of Court Street and Chicksgrove Lane is now</p>	

	ready for the letters to be added - these were not included in the grant and were thought to be either cast iron or aluminum; however, they were neither and made from ply or balsa wood. It has proved to be impossible to retrieve these wooden letters in a usable condition and 102 letters are required; the aluminum replacements will cost over £1000 and a price is being sought for cast iron equivalents.
