CAMPUS	ISSUES:	
15.06.40	Dedicated youth space - see background info attached; there is a potential community asset transfer of the 'motorcycle sheds' but a decision needs to be made at the meeting as the contract time for Rydon is critical. Steve Harris has confirmed that there is definitely asbestos in the sheds, but the exact extent is unknown (as with the Nadder Hall). The option for a space on the first floor may be an option - see an overview attached from Tony D.; a more formal explanation is expected from Steve Harris.	
15.06.41	Swimming pool works - there are 2 options: a. a complete rebuild at an estimated cost of £5-600k, or b. a complete refit using the existing infrastructure at an estimated cost of £260k. Actual costings are still awaited; but the £200k contribution from the PC is towards these prices.	
15.06.42	Parking around the Campus site – see attached note from Owen, the site manager. Plus, approval is required for 4 cars on the parking area between the allotments and	

	Weaveland Road.	
	The parking envisaged between the cricket nets and the swim pool would be available for	
	swim pool users once the construction site has finished working for the day.

15.06.43	Lower Recreation Ground - permission to use field on 31 st July for Community Choir.	
15.06.44	Change of Parish Council Boundaries - West Tisbury are happy to proceed on the land	
	swap basis.	
15.06.45	Purchase of small under-counter 'fridge for use of Tisbury Youth Cafe	
15.06.46	Nadder Valley Community Energy - this group, that has the support of the 2 Tisbury	
	PCs will be issuing a questionnaire to consult on the use of surplus funds for distribution

	I'm writing to inform you that, in accordance with Regulation 25 of the CIL Regulations 2010	
	and Regulations 11 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England)	
	Regulations 2012 that the Wiltshire Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) Charging Schedule	
	('the Charging Schedule') and Planning Obligations Supplementary Planning Document	
	(SPD) were adopted by Wiltshire Council on 12 May 2015.	
	The Charging Schedule enables Wiltshire to secure money from new development towards	
	the funding of infrastructure to support growth set out in the adopted Wiltshire Core Strategy.	
	The Charging Schedule was the subject of an independent examination conducted by an	
	Examiner appointed by Wiltshire Council. The Examiner's Report was published in March	
	2015 and the recommended modifications have been included in the adopted Charging Schedule. Wiltshire Council also approved a Regulation 123 List under Regulation 123(4) of	
	the CIL Regulations, which sets out the infrastructure that the council may fund through CIL,	
	and a CIL Instalments Policy under Regulation 69(B) of the CIL Regulations, which	
	accompany the Charging Schedule.	
	The Planning Obligations SPD provides detailed guidance on the application of Core Policy 3	
	of the Wiltshire Core Strategy. The SPD was subject to a four week public consultation	
	between March and April 2015. It sets out how the Council will use section 106 planning	
	obligations alongside other mechanisms for securing developer contributions towards	
	infrastructure, such as CIL, highways agreements and planning conditions.	
	The Charging Schedule, Planning Obligations SPD, Regulation 123 List and CIL Instalments	
	Policy will take effect on Monday 18 May 2015
