16.03.26	<p>Footpath from Court Street Bridge to the Burial Ground - the Joint Burial Committee intend to make an Area Board grant application towards the phase 1 and 2</p>	

	costs of this project. West Tisbury PC has put forward a sum of up to £600 towards match funding and the equivalent contribution from Tisbury PC would be up to £2000. Work on the application will be progressed for submission by the JBC Administrator and TPC Clerk and Tisbury P.Cnllrs are asked to support the application.	
16.03.27	<p>Boundary Changes between Tisbury and West Tisbury PCs - Wiltshire Council has come back to both Tisbury and West Tisbury Councils to indicate that a merger of the two parishes is unlikely to be discussed in the latest round of boundary changes unless both councils are in agreement.</p> <p>It seems that West Tisbury PC is unlikely to want a straightforward merger - but their Clerk will be consulting WTP.Cnllrs; the other option is for TPC to revert back to a swap of urban/rural areas of roughly equivalent populations as was suggested at the meeting in Salisbury in December 2014.</p> <p>P.Cnllrs are asked to consider this latter proposal for which an answer is required before the next meeting.</p>
