

# SAY 'NO' TO PARKING CHARGES IN TISBURY

Wiltshire Council is reviewing its parking strategy. If implemented, the proposals will impose parking charges in Tisbury. Tisbury Parish Council has responded to say that any parking charges will have a very detrimental effect on Tisbury's delicate economy. Most particularly, we think parking charges in Nadder Close car park would devastate the High St shops, as people would drive into Shaftesbury instead, where parking will continue to be free. We need you to reply as well, because Wiltshire Council usually takes more notice if lots of people respond.
