P.Cnllr MissFC spoke as a member of the public in highlighting that sheep (owner unknown) were escaping from a field owned by a local farmer through an inadequate stile onto the community meadow. It was noted that P.Cnllr SD along with Mr Arliss would be putting themselves forward as COB members (joining DW and MissFC) in order to further this proposal on behalf of the PC.	
15.02.40	<b>Dogs, Owners and Dog Poo Bin AT Lower Recreation Ground</b> P.Cnllrs noted that the Clerk had had contact with a few residents explaining that dogs should not be allowed under any circumstances onto the football field and risked a fine if spotted by the Dog Warden. The Clerk requested that the Dog Bin be removed, but P.Cnllrs felt that it should be retained.
