Mrs Scott spoke in favour of the Beckford Close planning application with particular reference to downsizing, plot size, solar power/rain harvesting, advice from pre-application and the proposals not being a speculative investment. b. 3 residents of Beckford Close then spoke against the application for the following reasons: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. The Beckford Close site, when first built, had been restricted to the present number of houses and only small extensions had been allowed until the rear entrance to 10 Beckford Close from Hindon Lane a few years ago. ii. Generally felt that the character of the development would be destroyed and there would be more noise from parking. iii. Privacy of immediate neighbours would be affected along with potential damage to boundary property. iv. Initial results of NHP indicated residents would prefer use of brown field sites for additional houses. v. Splitting of plots would be overdevelopment; but no objections to extensions. c. PCSO Pete Tscherniawsky updated those present on the STOP project, theft from gardens / garden sheds, Land Rovers(for spare parts) and specific local information concerning car break ins in Mere, Wyn Green and Fonthill Lakes.
