18.03.37	<p><b>Catholic Church land</b> - Members of the Catholic Church Development Committee updated Parish Councillors on the current plans for land to the rear of Trellis House following initial discussions with Planning Officers. A draft proposed site plan was displayed and questions answered from residents and councillors. The proposal to provide approx. 8 parking spaces for general public use was noted, but most concern was expressed about the road access to the site that was proposed, following advice from Planning/Highway Officers, to be via the access to the Lower Recreation Ground. Councillors deferred further discussion to agenda item 18.03.44.</p>

18.03.38	<p><b>ACoRP (Association of Community Rail Partnerships)</b> - Parish Councils are able to contribute towards 'community transport schemes' under Section 144 of the LGA 1972 that permits contributions to organisations/initiatives encouraging tourism. P.Cnllrs are therefore requested to ratify the decision taken at the March full meeting to support the application of the local Community Rail Partnership and bank incoming grants as appropriate. 18.03.39	<p><b>Fingerpost letters</b> - P.Cnllrs noted the previously awarded Area Board grant of 50% of the cost of 2 new fingerposts, but not the cost of replacement letters. The one fingerspost at the junction of Court Street and Chicksgrove Lane required 102 letters and current quotes were approx. £1020 for aluminium letters and £520 for cast iron letters.
