A resident from Knapp House spoke in favour of the application S 2012 1354, asking P.Cnllrs to note that not all the works in the application would necessarily be completed. b. The two representatives from Visit Wiltshire spoke to P.Cnllrs about the advantages to Tisbury in highlighting the attractions of the area in the Visit Wiltshire brochures (three in total), also available on line. The options available were discussed and costs detailed (£700pa for a two thirds page entry). 12.10.35	<p>a. Visit Wiltshire initiative for Tisbury - Cnllrs discussed the benefits to traders of using Visit Wiltshire but also the wider community. It was noted that it was more commonplace for PCs/TCs to fund the costs associated with the advertising rather than traders, who were also able to place individual adverts at an additional cost; it was generally thought that Tisbury needed to sell itself. Following a lengthy discussion, Cnllrs agreed that the Visit Wiltshire initiative would only be acceptable if a reduction in fee was negotiable (say to £300-400), potentially by involving neighbouring parishes (e.g. 6 parishes contributing £50 each) for a mention within the text.</p> <p>A letter would be sent to adjoining parishes to facilitate this.</p>	<p style="text-align: right;">MissFC</p>
