a. Declarations of Disclosable Pecuniary and Non-pecuniary interests already declared in the Register of Interests - none.

b. Declarations of Disclosable Pecuniary and Non-pecuniary interests not already declared in the Register of Interests - it was noted during the public session that P.Cnllrs Mrs J. Amos and Mrs P. Chave were member and member/secretary respectively of the Footpath Club in Tisbury and therefore had an interest in the topic raised on the AONB Sustainable Tourism initiative. It was not considered necessary to grant dispensations.

13.07.26 Public Participation and Presentations:
AONB Sustainable Tourism initiative; visitor footpath guide - the Chairman of the Footpath Club raised 4 issues with respect to the imminent publication of walks in the Tisbury area:

- i. The priorities of the initiative considering that there were already 36 walks in 2 booklets that were widely available in the area.
- ii. The apparent plagiarism of walks already provided in the 2 booklets.
- iii. The quality of information given about the walks.
- iv. The quality of the English.

It was suggested that the proposed walks be withdrawn and that the routes be checked in detail and proof read.
 Due to the timescales involved with this initiative, the Chairman indicated that this could be discussed as an emergency item following the other business under 'Other Matters'.

Additionally, this could be organised through the Footpath Officer later in the autumn.
