14.03.32	<p>Application to be considered 14/02024/FUL - Co-operative Retail Services Ltd, High Street, Tisbury, SP3 6HA - replacement of the existing bi-fold automatic doors with a sliding door, the redecoration of the front elevation details, the removal of one AC condenser and the replacement of another existing AC condenser. 14.03.33	<p>Recruitment of Village Warden and Public Toilet Cleaner - P.Cnllrs were updated on the recruitment of the VW replacement and recommended to appoint a candidate that was clearly outstanding above the others; being local, flexible and with appropriate skill sets. P.Cnllrs resolved to support the appointment.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Proposed MrsJA/seconded AG/8 in favour with 2 abstentions (work colleagues)</p>	
14.03.34	<p>ACF Detachment in Tisbury - Cnllr JBM agreed to make representations on behalf of the ACF at the Area Board meeting on 26th March to ensure the promotion of the proposed unit and highlight the need for secure accommodation.</p>	
14.03.35	<p>Rural Housing Needs Survey - P.Cnllrs resolved to request a Housing Needs Survey from WC in order to establish the current requirements in the village. Such a survey would benefit the NHP process, but also the plans for the potential development of land close to the catholic church.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Proposed JBM/seconded MMcG/unanimous</p>	
14.03.36 (7pm)	<p>Parking issues on the High Street</p> <p>i. <u>Complaints about the increased activity of Traffic Wardens on the High Street</u> - although complaints had been received about the increased presence of the Traffic Wardens, P.Cnllrs were reminded of the 1 hour parking restrictions and agreed the need for enforcement in the short term to ensure that spaces were available for shoppers and not used by residents and business owners for long stay parking during the day. The issue would be raised as a topic at the APM.</p> <p>ii. <u>Scope for additional places</u> - following a short discussion, a motion was proposed to start the process for an additional parking space north of the entrance to the dentist's car park. Although seconded, the motion was not resolved.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">Proposed DW/seconded MMcG/4 in favour with 5 against and 2 abstentions</p> <p>iii. <u>Yellow Line Markings following the road re-surfacing</u> - several anomalies in the re-marking of existing yellow lines in the High Street and Station Road; two of which raised safety concerns. WC would be approached to determine whether the markings as laid were errors or actually in line with the TROs. Lengths of road affected included stretches adjacent to Albany House, Arundell James Estate Agents, the Co-op access and the LRG.</p>	Clerk
