17.01.31	<p>Planning Applications:</p> <p><b>16/11528/FUL</b> - Chicksgrove Quarry, Chicksgrove, Tisbury, SP3 6LY - To import &amp; process imported natural building stone to improve processing, transport efficiency &amp; to assist in retaining full production &amp; employment in the quarry (24/01/17)</p> <p>P.Cnllrs resolved to support this application conditionally, with requests that the total number of traffic movements should not exceed the <u>current levels</u>. a movement of transport report and the condition of the bridge be assessed for safety.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Proposed SD/Seconded RW/3 in favour with 2 against and 1 abstention</b></p> <p><b>16/11929/FUL</b> - Community Centre Weaveland Road Tisbury SP3 6HJ - Application for B1 use on part of the first floor of the Nadder Centre. Previously the use of the area was outside of the scope of the original planning application, with the exception of 30 sq metres allocated for storage.
