	Dear Sir/Madam - I work for the National Trust at Place Farm Courtyard and walk to the office from the railway station.	
	Although it is less of an issue in the summer, in the winter when it is dark, it means walking down the narrow road until the pavement starts at Tisbury Row. This section of road can be quite busy and fast and I know a number of us have had near misses while walking the short stretch of road.	
	Because there are up to 70 staff at our office as well as numerous visitors to Messums, plus the other smaller offices, it feels like there would be some benefit in looking to make some road safety improvements in this area.	
	At the most basic level, I wonder if a white painted line with a pedestrian painted on (as has been done on the bridge by the railway station), would provide some limited protection? A better, but more expensive option, would be to create a raised footway in the field which would link to the Court Street footbridge.	
	I would be grateful if this suggestion could be brought up at the Parish Council meeting.
