Clerk's Update

- a. The wooden bench will need to be installed by a contractor that is Street Works Accredited (NRSWA) – the Clerk has arranged a site visit with a contracted on 12.05.2022.

- b. The Nadder Centre is holding a Family Fun 'Village Style' Fete on Saturday 6th August. There is potential for combining this with a celebration event for the Freedom of the Village award to former Wiltshire Councillor Deane.
- c. Parish On-line training is now available (£100per annum) for all Councillors and employees at pre-arranged sessions (during the day and evening). The Parish On-line package is a purpose built GIS system for those of us without a huge amount of technical knowledge to print OS maps (under licence from Ordnance Survey) and is ideal for all mapping needs. It is also possible to add new layers that are of local interest only.
- d. The Reading Room will soon have a 'fibre' connection to the internet that will, hopefully cause less disruption to any virtual meetings that are held.
- e. Work on the refurbishment of the Youth Hub has now started with the removal of some inner non-supporting walls.
- f. Councillors noted that Councillors Davison and Corp had approved the following invoices prior to the meeting:
 - AndyVan - £71.75 – cleaning materials.
 - GEM Plumbing Services - £270.00 – replacement of water heater in disabled access toilet.
 - GEM Plumbing Services - £70.00 – trace & identify a water leak in the disabled access toilet.
 - Ertrad Ltd – Advertising on Post Office screen.
 - Wiltshire Council – 1 no. DBS check
- g. Councillors noted that both the Skate Park and the Lower Recreation Ground – both Council owned assets - would be used for Jubilee events (2nd June & 5th June respectively).
