Press Release Station Works Planning Appeal Dismissed by Planning Inspectorate

Tisbury Parish Council has been informed today of the Planning Inspector's decision to dismiss the Station Works Planning Appeal submitted by Tisbury Community Homes. This was considered at an 8-day Planning Inquiry held in February and March 2023. The outline proposal to build a mixed development of up to 86 dwellings and a care home of up to 40 bed spaces therefore is refused.

The Council is delighted with the Inspector's decision and wishes to thank the community for its steadfast support over the last 2 years. It would also like to thank sincerely the volunteers, witnesses and neighbouring parishes for their support and the hard work they put in to prepare for and attend the Inquiry as well as its barrister. Mr Simon Bell.
